Rules

All games will be played under the <u>International Netball Federation rules</u>

Changes to INF Rules Change summary for 2020

All round robin games, a drawn result is acceptable. For all playoff games a winner is required, with a team winning by 2 goals & within the international netball federation rules. All finals a winner is required.

Scorer & Timekeeper

Each team is required to supply a scorer and/or timekeeper for their games whom must stand together on the sideline, midcourt.

Results

Results must be given to the competition coordinator at the completion of the game.

Referees

Each team to provide a referee for each game.

The competition will follow the National rules & regulations.

Equipment

Each team will provide a game quality ball.

Netball Format

Competition Co-ordinator: To be confirmed.

Teams of 7 players + subs

40-minute games, 2x minute quarter breaks & 3x minute half time

All teams must supply a scorer and timekeeper for each game.

The scorers must stand together courtside. Should any team fail to supply a scorer, the team shall not be able to question the score. Official scores will be recognised only on scorecards supplied.

There will be one court available for teams to warm up on before each round. Please ensure that we are using the space wisely & sharing it with other teams.



Points

4 Points – Win

2 Points – Draw

0 Points – Loss

In the event of two teams being tied, then the 'goals for' will be divided by the 'goals against' and the team will be ranked according to ratio.
