Grades: The competition is for individuals in the following grades:

Open Girls (age 12 – 18 yrs)

Novice Girls (anyone skating for < 1 year)

Junior Boys (age 12 – 15 yrs)

Novice Boys (anyone skating for < 1 year)

Senior Boys (age 16 – 18 yrs)

Age is as at the day of the event. (Grades are subject to change based on entries)

Entry: All entries are to be done online via EnterNOW system. Entries close on Wednesday 11th September at 5.00pm.

Students must fulfil the eligibility criteria for competition in secondary school sport as defined by the School Sport New Zealand. Students in Years 7 & 8 are not eligible to participate.

Entries will be accepted from schools which are not partner schools of the Canterbury Secondary Schools Sports Director's Office, but these entries will not be eligible to win trophies or other awards or be recognised in the final rankings of this Canterbury Secondary Schools event.

We will accept entries on the day of the event, but these entries will not be eligible to win trophies or other awards or be recognised in the final rankings.

Entry Fee: \$5.00 (inc GST) will be charged to the school account per entry received via EnterNow.

Any students who wish to enter on the day will need to pay the entry fee in cash at the time of registration.

Attire: Helmets are compulsory and additional safety equipment (knee, elbow and wrist protection) is recommended. There will be safety gear available on the day, provided free of charge by Cheapskates Skateskool.

School sport uniform is encouraged but not compulsory. Competitors should dress appropriately for the sport, including any compulsory safety equipment.
