TEAM AND GAME CONDITIONS

Grades:

Senior Girls/Boys & Mixed (Any age under 19)

Junior Girls/Boys & Mixed (Year 9 & 10 Only)

Separate competitions will only be organised for boys/girls/mixed teams if numbers allow.

A team consists of seven players.

2 x 15-minute halves.

Games are scheduled to commence at 3.15pm, 3.45pm, 4.15pm, 4.45pm

COMPETITION SCORING

Win = 4, loss = 0, draw = 2, win by default = 6, bonus 1 for every 5 goals scored.

UMPIRES

Umpires will be supplied by the venue.

EQUIPMENT

All equipment is supplied. White (non-marking) soled shoes are to be worn.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Schools are responsible for the health and safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue.

Schools must comply with the evacuation & risk management plan at the venue.

All equipment must be safe to use. All surfaces must be in a safe condition for games.

Game officials are responsible for the safety of students during play.

RESULTS

ENTRY

Schools are required to enter online via EnterNOW [www.enternow.co.nz], closing on Wednesday 9th October 5.00pm.

COST

Entry Fee: Schools will be charged \$37.00 per game played in a commercial venue. This will be charged to School account.
