COST

A Grade will cost \$1200. This cost **DOES NOT** include pool entry.

B & C Grade will cost \$600. There is no pool entry cost at the venues.

Entry fee is non refundable.



TEAM AND GRADE CONDITIONS

- 1. Teams will consist of up to a maximum of 13 players per team.
- 2. Teams must have a minimum of 10 players before entering a team.
- 3. Players named in in the A grade team is unable to play in the B grade team
- 3. Players named in an A grade team cannot then play in a B grade team.
- 4. A Grade games will be played on 4 x 5 min quarters stop clock. B Grade teams will play 4x 5 min quarters non stop clock.
- 5. There will be a maximum of 6 teams per grade per gender, able to enter the A grade competition.
- 6. If the number of entries exceed the spaces available, Canterbury Water Polo will look at previous results.
- 7. First named team on the draw will wear white caps unless unavailable.
- 8. Entering this competition is an acceptance that each team will abide by CWP code of conduct.
- 9. If the number of teams entered exceeds the number of places available, CWP may need to impose restrictions on the number of teams a school may enter.
- 10. There will be 2 points for a win, 1 for the draw and 0 for a loss.
- 11. After the round robin teams will be graded from 1st-6th before the final rounds.



DRAW

- All teams will be expected to play on their allocated night. If any of the above dates clash with a school event, a school representative must notify <u>competitions@canterburywaterpolo.org.nz</u> prior to the end of Term 3 2024.
- The draw will be available prior to the end of the Term on Thursday 26th September and will be available on the Sporty website.

RESULTS

- Results will be uploaded to the Canterbury Water Polo website each week and on Sporty.
- It is the school's responsibility to check these are correct.

TABLE DUTY

 A table duty will accompany the weekly draw. Failure to show to scheduled duty will result in a \$50 fine to the school concerned. Schools will not be able to play until this is paid.

EQUIPMENT

- It is expected that all teams will provide their own playing caps. If this is not possible, please let Canterbury Water Polo know.
- Canterbury Water Polo will provide playing balls.
- With direction from the Pool Controller, teams scheduled for the first game of the evening are asked to help with set up.
- Teams scheduled for the last game of the evening are kindly asked to help with pack down.

DEFAULTS

• If a team wishes to default, they must notify Canterbury Water Polo <u>at least 24 hours</u> <u>prior to the scheduled game</u> otherwise you will incur a \$50 default fine. A simple explanation will be needed for the purpose of the results sheet. Please note that a default is a loss and will not result in a reschedule of the game.
